JEO (Junior English Olympics) is from the Australia (UNICEP is Universal Centre of Educational Platform, they have IMEC (International Mathematics Olympiad), JEO and ISCO (International Science Challenge Olympiad) nearly 20 countries and regions such as Australia, UK, US, Canada, Turkey, Malaysia, Indonesia, Egypt, Thailand, Philippines, Vietnam, Mongolia (and more countries/ regions) participate in JEO every year. The main goal is to create and nourish friendly relations, international understanding and a spirit of sporting competitiveness between young people interested in the English language from all around the world. Students also can get the opportunity to get the scholarship in the preliminary round.

Junior English Olympics Introduction

The key competence tested by Junior English Olympics (JEO) is a non-profit organization and collaborated with Miss Man International Education in the purpose of promoting the importance of English language knowledge and bringing together children from different countries/ regions. JEO is an international Olympiad which promotes English language, challenges students around the globe to compete in English language knowledge and improves the cooperation between teachers. JEO also encourages the development of a shared sense of identity and integration, and serves as a role model for young people living together as one community. The main goal is to create and nourish friendly relations, international understanding and a spirit of sporting competitiveness between young people interested in the English language from all around the world.

Syllabus of JEO

JEO 1 – Grade 1 (Primary 1)

- Collocations, Synonyms, Antonyms, Identify the word from the Picture, Words Related to Animals, Phrases, Idioms, Nouns, Pronouns, Verbs, Adverbs, Adjectives, Articles, Prepositions, Conjunctions, Contractions, Word order, Punctuation, Simple tenses.
- Search for and retrieve information from various text types like stories and look for specific information in short texts like messages, invitations, etc.
- Ability to understand situation-based variations in functions like thanking, greeting, asking for permission, introducing (oneself), etc.
- Higher Order Thinking Questions

JEO3 - Grade 4 and 5 (Primary 4 and 5)

 Collocations, Idioms. Homonyms and homophones, Synonyms, Antonyms, Nouns, Pronouns, Verbs and Phrasal Verbs. Adverbs, Adjectives, Articles, Prepositions, Conjunctions, Punctuation and

JEO 2 - Grade 2 and 3 (Primary 2 and 3)

- Homophones, Collocations, Spellings, Gender, Singular-Plural, Words related to animals, Household things, Clothes, Basic emotions, Food, Animals and Pets, etc.
- One word Substitution, Synonyms, Antonyms, Nouns, Verbs, Adverbs, Adjectives, Contractions, Articles, Prepositions, Conjunctions, Tenses, Punctuations and Jumbled words, Basic Questions, Question Tags, Proverbs, Idioms, Word order, etc.
- Understand information through pictures, Time-table format, etc.,
- Acquire broad understanding of and look for specific information in short texts like messages, Invitations, etc.
- Ability to understand situation-based variations in functions like apology, greeting, introduction, request, etc.
- Higher Order Thinking Questions

JEO4 - Grades 6 (Primary 6)

 Collocations, Idioms, Homonyms and homophones, Synonyms, Antonyms, Nouns, Pronouns, Verbs and Phrasal Verbs, Adverbs, Adjectives, Articles, Prepositions, Conjunctions, Punctuation and Jumbled Words, Tenses, Narration, etc.

- Jumbled Words, Tenses, Narration, etc.
- Collocations, Phrasal verbs, Idioms, Synonyms, Antonyms.
- Understand information given in News reports, Time-tables, Messages, etc.
- Acquire broad understanding of and look for specific information in short texts like messages, menu card, etc.
- Ability to understand situation-based variations in functions like Requests, Refusals, Apologies, Word order, etc.
- Higher Order Thinking Questions

- Collocations, Phrasal verbs, Idioms, Synonyms, Antonyms.
- Understand information given in News reports, Time-tables, Messages, etc.
- Acquire broad understanding of and look for specific information in short texts like messages, menu card, etc.
- Ability to understand situation-based variations in functions like Requests, Refusals, Apologies, Word order, etc.
- Higher Order Thinking Questions

Senior 1 JEO 5- Grade 7 and 8 (Secondary 1 and 2)

- Tenses:Covers essential tenses effectively, but consider adding examples and exercises for each to reinforce understanding.
- Passive Voice:Good inclusion; ensure students practice transforming active sentences to passive.
- Infinitives: The distinction between bare and to-infinitives could use clarification with specific contexts.
- Articles & Clauses:Strong focus on articles and relative clauses; include real-life examples to enhance relevance.
- Reported Speech: Comprehensive, but ensure students practice changing direct to reported speech in various contexts.
- Prepositions: Consider providing visual aids or diagrams for prepositions of time, place, and movement.
- Nouns & Pronouns: Solid foundation, but consider adding exercises that differentiate between countable and uncountable nouns.

Senior 2 JEO 6- Grade 9 and 10 (Secondary 3 and 4)

- Mixed Tenses & Subjunctive:Important concepts; ensure students have a strong grasp of previous tenses before introducing mixed tenses.
- Conditional Sentences: Type 2 and 3 are crucial; include practical scenarios for better engagement.
- Modal Verbs:Good focus on probability; consider including modal verbs in different contexts (advice, necessity).
- Phrasal Verbs:Intransitive and three-word phrasal verbs are great additions; ensure students practice with context-driven exercises.
- Reported Speech:Excellent progression from JEO5; clarify the 'no change in tense' aspect with examples.
- Sentence Patterns & Connectives: Important for writing skills; incorporate writing assignments that utilize these patterns.
- Punctuation & Question Tags:Good inclusion; consider workshops or peer review sessions to practice these skills.
